Another common cause of frequent urination and lower abdominal pain is PID or pelvic inflammatory disease in women. Do your Kegels and pelvic tilts. Regular practice helps strengthen the muscles of the pelvis. Avoid triggers. Sit down to get dressed, and avoid heavy lifting and pushing (which you should be steering clear of anyway). Ask for pain relief. If the pain is severe, ask your practitioner about pain relievers. Consider physical therapy.
