The rich documentation concerning these people, commonly called Aztecs, includes, in addition to a few codices written before the Conquest, thousands of folios in the Nahuatl or Aztec language written by natives after the Conquest. The fundamental concepts of ancient Mexico presented and examined in this book have been taken from more than ninety original Aztec documents.
