In Another Aesthetics Is Possible Jennifer Ponce de León examines the roles that art can play in the collective labor of creating and defending another social reality. Focusing on artists and art collectives in Argentina, Mexico, and the United States, Ponce de León shows how experimental practices in the visual, literary, and performing arts have been influenced by and articulated with leftist movements and popular uprisings that have repudiated neoliberal capitalism and its violence. Whether enacting solidarity with Zapatista communities through an alternate reality game or using surrealist street theater to amplify the more radical strands of Argentina's human rights movement, these artists fuse their praxis with forms of political mobilization from direct-action tactics to economic resistance. Advancing an innovative transnational and transdisciplinary framework of analysis, Ponce de León proposes a materialist understanding of art and politics that brings to the fore the power of aesthetics to both compose and make visible a world beyond capitalism.

Entendiéndolo como realidad y como concepto, analiza las trayectorias sociopolíticas que ha seguido el Estado y los principales enfoques provenientes de la teoría estatal. Jessop, que percibe el Estado como una relación social y no como una "cosa" ni como un sujeto, rechaza por tanto explicaciones esencialistas y opta en cambio por desarrollar herramientas metodológicas con las que estudiar sus formas cambiantes, sus funciones y sus efectos. Esto, en la situación actual, se traduce en el estudio de una realidad en crisis. Las diferentes dimensiones del Estado afrontan actualmente tensiones y amenazas que provienen de diferentes ámbitos (la política, la economía, el desarrollo tecnológico, los movimientos sociales...) y le hacen propenso al fracaso. Por ello, muchas de las principales aportaciones de este libro tienen que ver con la identificación de estas amenazas, así como de los recursos de los que dispone el Estado para hacerles frente. En este sentido, aborda problemas tan acuciantes como la emergencia del autoritarismo en las democracias de los sistemas capitalistas o la normalización de las políticas de austeridad y de los estados de excepción. Asimismo, se ocupa del estudio de otros conceptos clave como el de hegemonía o el de gobernanza, y ayuda a clarificar a qué nos referimos cuando hablamos de "estados fallidos" o de "estados canallas".

State Crime in the Global Age brings together original writings from leading scholars in the field to explore the many ways that the use and abuse of state power results in grave social harms that outweigh, by far, the consequences of ordinary street crime. The topics covered include the crimes of empire, illegal war, the bombing of civilians, state sanctioned torture, state sacrifice of human lives, and judicial wrongdoing. The book breaks new ground through its examination of the ways globalization has intensified potentials for state crime, as well as bringing novel theoretical understandings of the state to the study of state crime, and exploring strategies for confronting state crime. This book, while containing much that is of interest to scholars of state crime, is designed to be accessible to students and others who are concerned with the ways individuals, social groups, and whole nations are victimized by the misuse of state power.

Passing: Two Publics in a Mexican Border City is an ethnography of the public sphere in Tijuana based on intensive fieldwork in 2006 and 2007 and numerous subsequent brief visits. Its central contribution is to develop an ethnographic method for apprehending how the border marks collective subjectivities in ways that illuminate the basic impasses of publicness in general. She examines major communicative genres such as print news, street demonstrations, internet forums, and popular ballads, as well as a variety of minor genres: family discussions, thank-you notes at religious shrines, police encounters, workplace banter, and personal interview. The question of collective subjectivity that she traces through all these examples is particularly live, politically and socially, at the border, where US legal categories forcefully shape the logics of class exclusion-and thus national membership and democratic possibility-that are general in Mexico.
