Also, it is with the addition of the Black Nile (Barya or Baro River) that Ethiopian rivers' share of the Nile becomes 86%. This means that, despite the little and yet disguised acknowledgment given to Ethiopian rivers by the national authorities, the facts on the ground confirm that Oromian rivers alone contribute about 80% of the Black Nile ...
