Spread of new means of communication and transport, urbanization and industrialization, social reforms, expansion of western education, and a universalistic legal system were construed as the normative components of modernization in India. As regards structural modernization, rational bureaucratic systems of administration and judiciary, industrial bureaucracy and army emerged.
