Periodontal diseases in the child and adolescent—Oh ... Periodontal diseases are a group of infectious diseases that mainly include gingivitis and periodontitis. Gingivitis is the most prevalent form of periodontal disease in subjects of all ages, including children and adolescents. Less frequent types of periodontal disease include aggressive periodontitis, acute necrotizing ulcerative gingivitis and various diseases of herpesviral and fungal origin.

Periodontal disease can present itself in juveniles and in the past we used ' Juvenile Periodontitis ' to describe this rather destructive and aggressive form of the disease which effected adolescents and children. Nowadays, after the revised classification of periodontal diseases in 1999, the term ' Aggressive Periodontitis ' is used.

The Basic Periodontal Examination in children It's much less common in children. If you have gum disease, your gums may bleed when you brush your teeth and you may have bad breath. This early stage of gum disease is known as gingivitis. If gingivitis is not treated, a condition called periodontitis can develop.

Gum disease—NHS Periodontal disease is a serious bacterial infection that destroys the gums and supporting structures of the teeth. It is also called gum disease. The main cause is plaque buildup on the teeth. Children are more likely to have gingivitis, the mildest form of the disease. Symptoms include red, swollen, sore gums.

gingiva and periodontal problems in children For children, the main cause of gingivitis is usually poor dental hygiene. However, certain diseases can increase a child's risk, including Kindler syndrome, type 1 diabetes, Down syndrome and Papillon–Lef è vre syndrome, to name a few.

Gum Disease Treatment For Kids—Colgate It is now well accepted that bacteria in dental plaque are the major villains of periodontal diseases, which are infections of the structures around the teeth (the gums, the cementum, the periodontal ligament, and the alveolar bone). Calculus is a mineralized form of dental plaque which facilitates plaque deposition and irritates the gums.

Periodontal Diseases and Dental Caries in Children with ... Chronic gingivitis Chronic gingivitis is a common condition.Untreated, gingivitis may progress to gum disease or periodontal disease. Gingivitis is painless in the early stages, but may lead to bleeding gums and other oral problems. Bleeding gums are only one sign of gingivitis. Gums become red and swollen, teeth may become loose or may eventually fall out.
