The most important part of a good suturing technique is whether the knot tying method of the suture is correct or not. Different types of knots are used for different types of wounds. Square Knot - One-Hand Technique: A two-hand technique is often used to tie the square knot; however on some occasions it's not the right technique. In those moments the one-hand square knot technique is used, either the left hand or the right.

Surgical Knots Used in Wound Suturing

The simple running suture may be locked or left unlocked. The first knot of a running locked suture is tied as in a traditional running suture and may be locked by passing the needle through the loop preceding it as each stitch is placed. This suture is also known as the

Sutures should be placed approximately 2-5 mm from the wound edge and 5mm apart (this may vary depending on the size of the wound and location) Knots should be placed on either side of the wound edge and can be used to subtly adjust the edges to lie together.

Constrictor: First Use in Surgery and Research. A completed surgical knot is sometimes out of sight. Worse, common techniques may create an unreliable stack of Half Hitches instead of the intended Square (Reef) knot. This partly explains the custom of adding multiple extra Half Knots. The Constrictor eliminates this risk.
