When the epidemic revived again in the summer of 1849, the first case in the sub-district "Lambeth; Church, 1st part," was in Lower Fore Street, on June 27th; and on the commencement of the epidemic of the present year, the first case of cholera in any part of Lambeth, and one of the earliest in London, occurred at 52, Upper Fore Street, where also the people had no water except what they obtained from the Thames with a pail, as I ascertained by calling at the house.

Mode of Communication of Cholera(John Snow, 1855)

At 5 Slater's Alley, Rotherhithe, July 29th, a labourer, aged 33, cholera 3.5 days – Thames Tunnel water, fetched from John's Place. Rotherhithe was badly effected. and John Snow mentions Charlotte Row, Ram Alley and Silver Street as "places where the scourge fell with tremendous severity".
